John R. Farrell Jr., 30, moving company employee

John R. Farrell Jr., who had worked for a Westminster moving company and was an avid sports fan, died of a brain tumor Wednesday at his Reisterstown home. He was 30.

Mr. Farrell was born in Coatesville, Pa., and raised in Brookfield, Conn., Syracuse, and Schenectady, N.Y.

A resident of Reisterstown since 1991, Mr. Farrell was home-schooled. He was employed as a mover with Precision Moves in Westminster and later worked in the company's advertising department. He stopped working last year because of failing health.

Mr. Farrell was 25 when a brain tumor was diagnosed, family members said.

He was a member of and an assistant youth leader at Freedom Christian Church in Eldersburg. He also was active in the church's outreach programs.

Mr. Farrell was an enthusiastic Orioles and Ravens fan. He also collected baseball cards and enjoyed compiling sports statistics on his home computer.

Services were held yesterday at Freedom Christian Church.

Mr. Farrell is survived by his parents, John R. Farrell Sr. and Donna L. Farrell of Reisterstown; two brothers, Michael J. Farrell of Reisterstown and Daniel B. Farrell of Towson; his paternal grandparents, James R. and Mickey Farrell of Falls Church, Va.; and maternal grandparents Dale F. and Marion J. Spangler of Nazareth, Pa.
